**Test Taking Tips for Parents & Students** 

1. Make sure your child gets an ample, normal amount of sleep the night before the test 2. Mark testing days on your calendar to help remind you and your child when the testing will take place and plan your preparations. 3. The student should eat a nutritious and filling breakfast. Avoid high sugar cereals which can make the student hyper and/or unfocused. 4. Set aside time each night prior to the test for several weeks to review the concepts that will be covered. 5. Make sure the student is on time (if not early) on the days of testing 6. Set a backup alarm to avoid the possibility of oversleeping 7. If your child is sick please contact the school immediately to inform them. 8. Try not to put too much pressure on the student. Reinforce that as long as they worked hard in preparation and did their absolute best you will be proud of them. 9. Encourage your child and keep a positive attitude about testing in general around your child and emphasize their ability to demonstrate what they have learned rather than the consequences of not passing. 10. Finally, pray for your child, their teacher and our school.
